1. I, must have completed the 101 basic keelboat course or challenged the course with a 200 series vetting process.

Must have completed maneuvers & points of sail as follows:

- Close Hauled
- Beam Reach
- Close Reach
- Beam Reach
- Broad Reach
- Luffing
- Star Board Tack
- Jibing
- Head-to Wind
- Run
- Sailing – by – the – Lee
- In Irons
- Port Tack
- Tacking
- Stand – on
- Give – way

2. I, understand the helm commands:

- “Heading Up”
- “Ready About” – “ Ready” – “Helms – a – Lee” (or “Coming About” or Tacking”)
- “Bearing Away”
- “Prepare to Jibe” – Ready” – “Jibe Ho” or (“Jibing”)

3. I, acknowledge full understanding of the navigation rules based on the USCG Navigation Rules and Regulation Handbook and understand how to use a sextant and the electronic GPS system.
4. I, comprehend the proper use of the safety gear and the procedures for usage according to the Federal requirement for a 25-foot recreational sailboat.
5. I can differentiate the location and color of the navigation lights. Recognize and state the purpose of lateral aids to navigation by color, shape and numbering containing preferred channel markers.
